

ADVISORY PLANNING COMMISSION

MEMBER RECRUITMENT

The Village Council is currently in the process of recruiting volunteers to sit as members of the **Advisory Planning Commission**.

The Advisory Planning Commission is a seven member statutory committee that is appointed to a two-year term by the Village Council under the provisions of Section 898 of the Local Government Act. Their mandate is to advise Council on all matters respecting land use, community planning and/or proposed bylaws, as referred to them at the discretion of Council. All residents of the Village and non-resident property owners are eligible for membership.

This position is a volunteer position and as such the successful candidates would be expected to serve without pay. It is estimated that the Advisory Planning Commission would be required to sit on average once per month.

All interested candidates are asked to provide a written submission to the Village by December 31, 2011. The written submission should include a short biography that in part outlines your background and related interests.

Membership on the Advisory Planning Commission is a very interesting and rewarding responsibility that has considerable impact on how your community will evolve and grow in the future. Council looks forward to hearing from all interested candidates.
