Re: Metro North Transmission Study

---

Thank you for your letter of June 7, 2016, on the Metro North Transmission Study. I would like to address a few items you raised in your letter in order to provide a better understanding of our study and consultation efforts to date.

We're aware of the impacts our infrastructure can have on communities. That's why we've been consulting with Anmore since July 2013 when we began this study. Since that time we have had six meetings with Anmore staff and council, held a public meeting in Anmore and responded to more than 40 letters and e-mails from both the Village of Anmore and its residents.

In addition, we hosted an open house in Port Moody with invitations extended to Anmore residents. We have also offered to meet with potentially affected property owners and are hosting another community information open house later this month.

We've identified Alternative 2 for further study, technical work and consultation. As part of that we've advanced a design for Anmore that would see a reduction in the overall number of poles in the right-of-way. For the residential area, we would remove 13 wooden poles and replace them with three taller monopoles. This would be a net reduction of 10 poles. We also we want to work with residents in this study phase to better understand their unique concerns before a decision on a leading alternative is made.

We are always available to meet with you at your convenience to continue our discussion around potential benefits to Anmore. We welcome your thoughts and suggestions.

We look forward to meeting with residents at our open house on Thursday, June 23 and hope you and your council can also join us.
