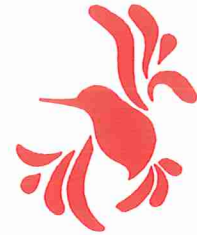

**Re: Metro North Transmission Study – May 2016 Update**

It would appear that the route through the Village of Anmore is becoming the preferred option for the required increase in hydro service capacity for the Lower Mainland.

The Village would like to express disappointment in B.C. Hydro's consideration of the Anmore option for this service expansion. We have several concerns about the new power poles and lines that will be going through our village and the methods by which residents, members of Council and staff are being informed and engaged throughout the process.

B.C. Hydro's operations have a huge impact on our community. In addition to the existing power lines already running through the middle of Anmore, there is the use of the Buntzen Lake Recreation area that needs to be considered. Although residents are fortunate to live near Buntzen Lake, B.C. Hydro should be reminded of the negative impact that the use of this area has on the Village. Increased traffic, particularly on warm days, creates noise, congestion, increased parking problems and reduces the service life of our arterial routes in and out of the Village at an increased rate and we receive little compensation for any of this.

The Village of Anmore strongly opposes this expansion as it will have no benefit to the residents of our community. We request that B.C. Hydro pursue one of the other identified options.
