### If you come by car:

- ◆ The main viewing area is on the fixed pier leading to the dock.
- ◆ With increasing numbers in attendance, it has become impossible to have everyone on the lower dock. Please also stay off the ramps leading down to the dock.
- ◆ The floating docks are for those arriving by boat, guests, and dignitaries, Veterans and their families are also welcome on the dock.

### If you would like to come by boat:

- ◆ Again, due to increasing number of boats attending, dock/raft space is also limited and we now need you to make a reservation. Please contact [TonyGojevic@telus.net](mailto:TonyGojevic@telus.net) as soon as possible if you would like to bring your boat around.
- ◆ All communications are on VHF 69, call "Belcarra Raft Master" as you round Admiralty point so you can receive your berthing instructions.
- ◆ Docking and rafting will commence at 08:30 and must be finished by 09:45 hrs.
- ◆ Vessels with reservations arriving late will not be accommodated.

### Schedule of activities:

- ◆ Pre-ceremony setup and music starts 09:30 hrs.
- ◆ Formal ceremony commences at 10:35 hrs with the sounding of an air raid siren.
- ◆ Ceremony and address
- ◆ Flanders Fields
- ◆ Prayer
- ◆ Last Post
- ◆ 2 minutes of silence (11:00 hrs) Squadron and other wreaths will be presented during the address will be laid at this time)
- ◆ Ceremony closing and fly-over (weather permitting, fly over by John Northey and his Air Squadron)
- ◆ Lunch follows at the park shelter on a donation basis
