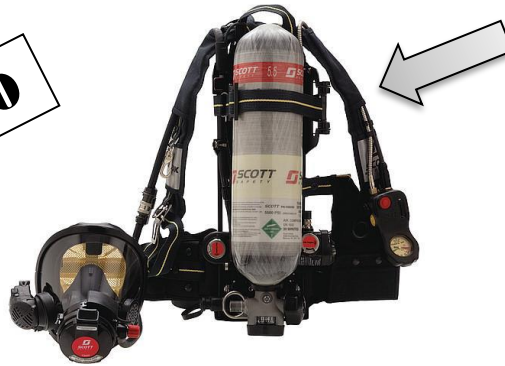


The Sasamat Volunteer Fire Department SCBA Fundraiser Update June 2016
