

IMPORTANT NOTIFICATION CHANGES IN SERVICE



VILLAGE OF ANMORE BRUSH CHIPPING PROGRAM SPRING 2016

The Village of Anmore will continue offering its Brush Chipping Program to residents.

Important: The Village Hall will **no longer** be accepting registration via telephone to take part in the program and will not be taking any special requests for this service. It will be each homeowner's responsibility to ensure that they arrange for their brush chipping to be appropriately placed, by the deadline, at the roadside adjacent to their property.

Deadline: Sunday, April 24, 2016 ~ In order to ensure that your brush chipping pile is picked up throughout the week of April 25, 2016 – April 29, 2016, **you must have it out by end of day April 24, 2016.**

Requirements: Only one (1) brush chipping pile is allowed and it must not exceed the maximum volume of four (4) cubic meters (4 feet wide / by 4 feet high / by 9 feet long).

Our service provider will begin brush chipping Monday, April 25, 2016 and continue throughout the Village during the scheduled week and will not be returning to any homes that did not meet the Sunday, April 24, 2016 deadline.

*To dispose of other yard waste materials, we suggest using your new organics waste cart (for acceptable materials).
