



The following projects will have an impact on our customers and staff:

STATION UPGRADES

Main Street – Science World Station

Night work continues to take place at Main Street-Science World Station between 7 p.m. and 7 a.m. Passengers should not be affected by this work.

Metrotown Station

The elevator at Metrotown Station is out of service until spring 2016 while three new elevators and the new Centre Stationhouse are being built. A HandyDART Accessible shuttle will operate approximately every 15-20 minutes between Metrotown and Patterson stations during peak hours. Stroller passengers, and those requiring access to Metrotown because of the elevator outage can take the "Metrotown Special" community shuttle from Patterson or Royal Oak Stations.

New Westminster Station

Upgrades to New Westminster Station begin in spring 2015. Once complete, the upgrades will improve accessibility, capacity, safety and security at the station.

Beginning in May 2015 and continuing until summer 2015, construction crews will focus on replacing the east escalator and upgrading the stairs, at the Eighth Street entrance, and the west escalator and stairs by the bus loop. Painting and the installation of new window glazing will also begin at platform level, and the emergency exits at the north and south sides of the platform will be painted.

- Station access from Eighth Street will be closed. Passengers will be redirected to the Carnarvon Street entrance.
- The escalator and stairs from the bus loop to the concourse level will be closed. Passengers will be redirected along McNeely Street to the Carnarvon Street entrance, or through the parkade to the existing moving walkway that provides access up to the concourse level.

POWER RAIL REPLACEMENT

Expo Line

Power rail replacement work continues on the Expo Line. During power rail work, SkyTrain single tracks (trains travel on the same track in alternating directions) around the active work area. SkyTrain passengers on Expo line may experience minor delays during power rail work.

Power rail replacement work is performed on Sunday to Thursday.

- Power rail work has returned to the area between Nanaimo and Stadium-Chinatown stations. Power rail work will start at 9 p.m. All passengers will board and disembark SkyTrain from the eastbound platforms at Commercial-Broadway and Main Street-Science World stations. Passengers may experience delays of 10-15 minutes.
- Power rail work will be delayed until 10:15 p.m. on Wednesday, May 13 due to the Whitecaps soccer game.
- Power rail work is cancelled on Thursday, May 14 due to the U2 concert at Rogers Arena.



TRACK WORK

Lougheed Town Centre Station

On Saturday, May 23, and Saturday, May 30, Evergreen Line track work will take place at Lougheed Station, and SkyTrain will single track around the work area. The westbound platforms at Lougheed and Production Way-University stations will be closed. All passengers will board and disembark SkyTrain from the eastbound platform at Production Way and Lougheed stations.

EVERGREEN EXTENSION PROJECT

Coquitlam Central Station (West Coast Express)

Starting on May 4, crews will begin to restore access between the main parking lot and passenger pick-up and drop-off area. Temporary pedestrian detours near the south passenger pick-up and drop-off area will be in effect for approximately two months. Passengers should follow the instructions of traffic control personnel and posted signs while construction is underway.

The road and pathway connection between the main parking lot and the south passenger pick-up and drop off area will be reinstated in July 2015.

Lougheed Town Centre Station

Construction for the section of Lougheed Station that will house the Evergreen extension of the Millennium Line is ongoing. Work is taking place Monday to Saturday, between 7 a.m. and 8 p.m. Customers may notice some construction noise, but this work will not affect service.

While work is underway, pedestrians and transit users are should watch for signs regarding temporary pedestrian detours. Work should be complete by early June.

The passenger pick-up and drop-off and taxi parking will be reinstated in mid-May, and the temporary passenger pick-up and drop-off area in the west parking lot will close.
